



Nynehead Cricket Club **Club Constitution**

1. The aim of Nynehead Cricket Club (the Club) is to promote the amateur game of cricket at all levels of ability and all ages.
2. The Club is open to anyone interested in cricket regardless of sex, age, disability, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion or other beliefs.
3. The club will particularly seek to support and promote cricket within the parish of Nynehead and surrounding parishes.
4. No player shall be paid to play for the Club.
5. The committee should consist of a maximum of twelve members. In exceptional cases the committee may co-opt as required. A quorum of five members is required for committee meetings.
5. (a) The committee will try to include at least two residents of the parish of Nynehead.
6. All profits whether from donations, sponsorship, match fees, membership fees, grants or any other source shall be reinvested in the Club.
7. An AGM shall be held once every twelve months, to which all members may attend.
8. The AGM shall be chaired by the Club president or the past year's Chairman or vice-chair in their absence. The AGM shall elect the positions of Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer for the coming year. (Other officers may be elected at this time or may be appointed by the elected officers later).
9. Any additional AGM business received in writing by the Club secretary two weeks before the date of the AGM.
10. An EGM may be called by the committee, or if requested in writing by five members of the club. Two weeks notice will be given to members of an EGM.
11. An EGM shall be called to fill the vacancy of Chairman, Secretary or Treasurer.
12. Should the committee wish to dissolve the Club, an Extraordinary General Meeting of club members should be called. If the EGM is in agreement with the decision of the committee, all assets should be transferred to the Somerset Cricket Federation, a registered charity, or other body agreed by the EGM. The Club shall also consult Nynehead Parish Council and the Somerset Cricket Foundation before said EGM.
